## **SUMMER MODULAR SESSION COSTS:**

- Tuition - \$220 per credit hour / CEU
- New students must submit an ILN application - \$45 application fee
- Certificate fee per TESOL or Phonetic Reading course - \$150
- One-time matriculation fee - \$50
- Dormitory lodging - \$15 per day or \$85 per week (lodging only no meals)

## **ORIENTATION FOR SUMMER MODULAR SESSION COURSES:**

- Orientation for each summer modular session will be held at 7:45 a.m. in Room 120 on the first day of the session – for example: Session I on May 7, Session II on May 16, Session III on May 28, Session IV on June 6, and Session V on June 17.
