## **SUMMER MODULAR SESSION COSTS:**

- Currently enrolled students - \$120 per credit hour / CEU
- Students not currently enrolled - \$180 per credit hour / CEU
- New students must submit an ILN application - \$45 application fee
- Certificate fee per TESOL or Phonetic Reading course - \$150
- One-time matriculation fee - \$50
- Dormitory lodging - \$15 per day or \$85 per week (lodging only)
